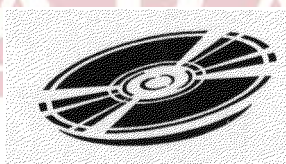


## Tutor-marked Assignment A

2. Say what kind of nouns are the following words:
  - a. flock truth Peter cat stone (5 marks)
  - b. Give the gender of each of the above words. (5 marks)
3. Identify the verbs and the pronouns in these sentences:
  - a. Tom arrived at the station early, and he went to the ticket office to buy a ticket. (2 marks)
  - b. When can I see the exhibition? (2 marks)
  - c. Give him the money, Barney! (2 marks)
  - d. I went through the gate and saw a large crowd of people; they were queuing for the cinema. (2 marks)

4. Put the following sentences into the Past Tense: (Simple; i.e. one word):

- a) Peter is my best friend.
- b) The ship brings us into the harbour.
- c) We drink the coffee; it has a delicious flavour.
- d) Parents give their children presents at Christmas.
- e) When the whistle blows, the teams swing into action.

- a) 1<sup>st</sup> Person Singular
- b) 3<sup>rd</sup> Person Plural
- c) 1<sup>st</sup> Person Plural.
- d) 2<sup>nd</sup> Person singular

8. Identify the Pronouns in the following sentences:

- a) Paul gave me a bar of chocolate.
- b) The train will take us to London.
- c) Are you coming to visit us tomorrow?
- d) It will be raining, but it won't stop us going out.
- e) Give us some more cake, please.
