

## Different Words - Same Meanings

- b) **Nouns.** Nouns where the same word has more than one meaning will be far less common than Verbs, as they are more definite. Here are some examples:

act	= deed, action
archer	= Bowman, marksman
area	= district, region
broom	= brush
building	= edifice, structure
cat	= feline
chair	= seat
channel	= waterway
damp	= moisture, humidity
dare	= challenge
dog	= canine
event	= happening
evil	= wickedness
find	= discovery
ghost	= spectre, phantom
heat	= warmth
house	= residence, abode
joke	= pleasantry
name	= appellation, monicker (slang)
road	= thoroughfare, highway
steam	= vapour

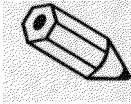
- c) **Adjectives.** Again these are not so common, and this will be the last list. After it, we will have another Activity which sums up what we have been looking at in Verbs, Nouns, and Adjectives.

beautiful	= pretty, good looking
big	= large, great
busy	= occupied
broad	= wide
full	= replete, packed
hard working	= industrious
intelligent	= clever
little	= small, tiny
red	= scarlet
tall	= high
wide	= broad
